### **Application file (documents to be submitted):**

1. Application file form, see Annex.
2. Summary of the works (maximum four pages - A4 format), including illustrations, consisting of the following:
  - Introduction describing the objectives of the study ;
  - Description of the works carried out, the results obtained ;
  - Overview: interest for AFAIA's activities sectors in relation to the theme of the symposium, innovative nature of the works.

The text should be written in French or English.

3. Report of the works, presented and marked by a teacher or an examination board.
4. Justification of the mark awarded by the teacher or an examination board with their comments, ranking if any, certified by the establishment and signed by a representative person.

Only complete application files sent before the deadline of 25<sup>th</sup> September 2020 will be considered.
